About KVK, Thoubal

Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Thoubal District is the only KVK in the state hosted by the Department of Agriculture, Manipur. It is located at Wangbal, Khangabok about 25km towards the south of Imphal, along the Indo-Myanmar NH-2 Road. It was sanctioned by ICAR in the year 2005-06. However, the Institute became fully functional from April,2007 manned by 16 staff.

Activities of KVK, Thoubal

Every year, as per the mandate given to the KVK and as per the action plan prepared, the KVK takes up different activities to fulfill these activities. These activities are taken up with an objective to uplift the farmers of the district, particularly the small and marginal farmers. The mandatory activities consist of mainly need based training programmes related to the activities taken up that is OFTs and FLDs, along with trainings on farmers' demands, besides which many other Extension activities are taken up such as development of leaflets, folders, publication of articles in the news paper, TV and Radio talks etc.

S. Anita Devi

a successful farmer on- Fish cum broiler farming started rearing 150 birds/0.5 ha pond. Along with 5000 fish fingerlings in the ratio of 30% surface feeder, 30% middle feeder and 40% bottom feeder. Liming with quick lime was done in the fish pond at 300kg/ha in four splits to increase PH for correction of acidity. She sold the birds at 49 days.

By selling the bird at Rs.120/kg she could earn an income of Rs.12,000.00 from one batch of broiler and from such 6 batches she could earn about Rs.72,000.00. From the fish she could earn a profit of 60,000.00 in a year totalling to Rs.(72,000.00 + 60,000.00) = Rs.1,32,000.00. Earlier from the fish alone she could get a profit of Rs.40,000/- only.

Mallika Hybrid Variety of mango, though old is doing very well in Manipur. It needs to be popularized in Manipur in view of its different good characters such as regular bearing, keeping quality, eating quality, tolerance to many diseases, easily manageable plant size, etc. It can be propagated either by epicotyle/stone grafting to maintain its purity. Top working is a very successful method of spreading the variety.

On farm trial is an approach of adaptive research conducted on farmers' field within their farming system perspective in their active participation and under their management. The objective of OFT is to develop technologies which might help solve problems of group of farmers in a defined study area.
